Pet Service Next Sunday

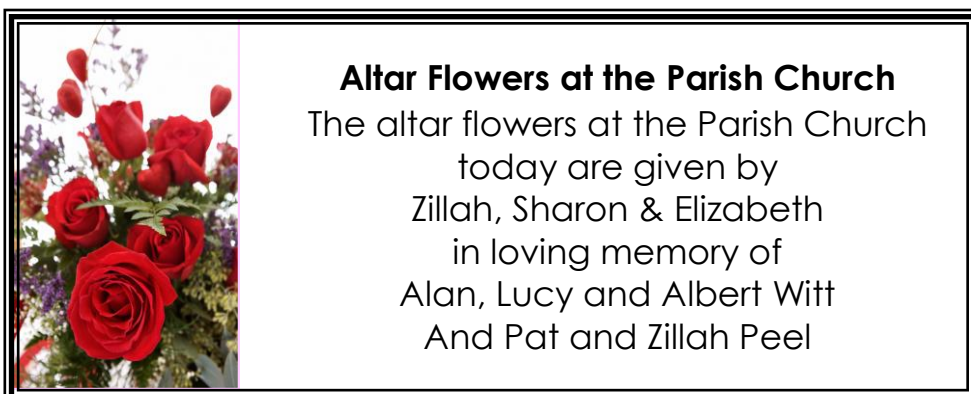
