GDPR _ General Data Protection Regulations (effective 25th May 2018)

As you are probably aware, these new regulations are now in place. To comply with this all Churches and PCCs must actively seek permission from individuals for holding and using their personal information. This includes addresses, phone numbers and emails, in fact any information which can identify a living person.

With this in mind we ask that:

- all people whose phone numbers are in the magazine to email or write to the office to confirm that they are happy for this to continue.
- If you are on the Electoral Roll, please sign and tick the sheets on the clipboards at the back of both Churches. If you do not we will have to remove you from the roll. We are also asking you to tick the sheet to give permission for us to keep your contact details.
- If you are not on the Electoral but we have any of your contact details, please sign the form to enable to keep in touch.
