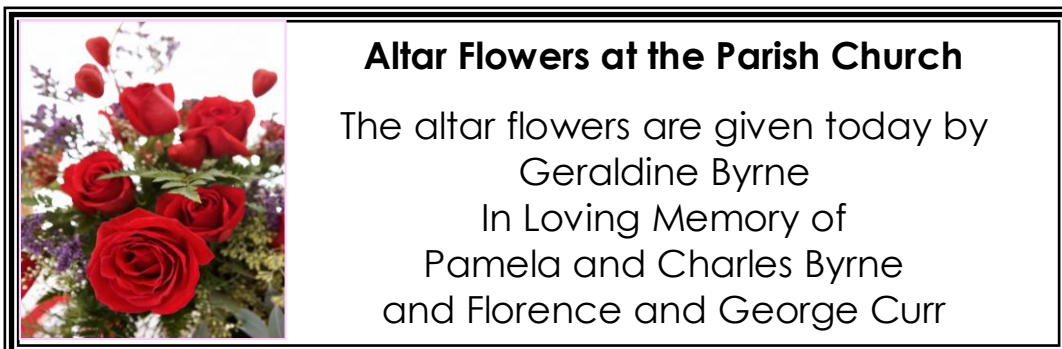
From The Vicarage
