Langton & Major York's Road Works and Petition

The works on the Langton Road between the Church and Dornden Drive have started and will continue until Saturday 27th July. The work is to be carried out overnight but starts early at 8 pm, with the road closed until 5 am the following morning. This will not interfere with Church on Sunday 21st, but may be a problem for Choir practice on 19th and 26th.

Major York's Road will be closed from the bottom end up to Hungershall Park starting on the 22nd July for 8 weeks.
