This annual event run by Friends of Kent Churches

(www.friendsofkentchurches.co.uk) will take place this year on Saturday 14th September. The idea is to get sponsorship to visit as many churches in Kent as possible either by walking or cycling between 10 am and 6 pm on the day. It is great fun and there are delicious refreshments provided by many of the churches on the way!!! The money raised goes towards paying for repairs and renovations of churches in Kent. It is split equally between the Diocese and St Pauls. Last year we raised £610. Kent raised £140,000 as a county!
