This annual event run by Friends of Kent Churches

(www.friendsofkentchurches.co.uk) will take place this year on Saturday 14th September. The idea is to get sponsorship to visit as many churches in Kent as possible either by walking or cycling between 10 am and 6 pm on the day.
