The new Roll will take effect on Sunday 27th April 2025 in readiness for the APCM on Thursday 15th May. Only those registered on the Electoral Roll are entitled to attend the APCM. Electoral Roll application forms are available at the back of both the Parish Church and the Church Centre.
